- ✿ **THINK SAFETY** – Remember, safety first at all times. Open or OUT. Keep those actions open and the muzzles down range. If you see someone not handling a gun safely, don't hesitate for a second to let them know of their mistake. You may not get a second chance. Safety is everyone's job!
- ✿ **Women on Target (WOT)** – Thanks to Glenn Hamerly and some female members of the club, we will host an NRA WOT event on **Saturday, May 22nd, 2010**. - ✿ **Club Calendar** – The 2010 club calendar is now out and posted on the web site and at the club. On it you will find all the important dates regarding meetings etc. . . .
- ✿ **Work weeks for league teams**—Remember that teams that shoot league are supposed to supply help at ATA shoots. Sign up for the work schedule can be done at the upcoming captains meeting on April 13th. We had some trouble last year with teams not signing up for work. This resulted in help being determined by drawing teams from a hat and then scheduled to work. To avoid a lot of confusion and hard feelings, PLEASE take time to work your scheduled ATA shoot and make sure your team shows up. *REMINDER – If your TEAM volunteers 4 people to be present for an entire ATA DAY, your team will be exempt from all other league work assignments! Even if all the teams must go back into the drawings pool to complete the work assignments, if your team is exempt for working an ATA shoot, you will NOT be put back into the drawings – everyone else will.*
- ✿ **Club house addition**—The major work has been completed on our new addition. A lot of things still need to be done yet but enough is done that the CWTA shoot went off with out any problems. I can not tell you how many shooters had nothing but great things to say about our clubhouse. They liked the added room, new bathrooms, and the view looking out over the trap fields.
- ✿ **Captains Meeting** - Mandatory Captains Meeting to be held **April 13th, 2010. Rosters are due at this meeting! A new and current roster must be completed. DO NOT** just copy the roster from last year. We have many bad addresses, phone numbers and e-mail addresses because of this. - ✿ **CWTA Shoot** –Was held at Weston on March 14th. The turnout for the event was great. We had 238 shooters participate on Sunday a new record of shooters for a CWTA event.
- ✿ **League Starts May 2nd** – 1st Score is Due **May 6th**. Be sure to pay membership and league fees before shooting or your score will not count. League Workweeks are posted at the club. Be sure to check when your team is scheduled to work. Remember, EVERYONE is expected to mark a round for the next squad.
- ✿ **Weston Youth Program** – Will be having its first meeting on Saturday April 10th at 6:00 pm. Parents need to attend this meeting. Practice will start on Sunday April 18th at 6:00pm. Shooter should bring their ATA cards to the meeting on April 10th.
- ✿ **INTRODUCTION TO TRAP** – A six week course introducing new people to the sport of trap shooting will again be sponsored by the club and offered to anyone interested and holding a Hunters Safety Certificate. Contact Russ Howland for more information.
- ✿ **BE KIND TO SETTERS** - Do the setters a favor, check to see if the house is clear before starting a round. Let the setters know when you are finished (if they are left in the house during the round). Shut the microphones off after a round finishes. ALWAYS yield to the light bulb. If the light is on – STOP & UNLOAD IMMEDIATELY. If you see a setter not using the safety light, report it to the club supervisor.
