- ✿ **Welcome** – We would like to welcome all new and returning members for another season of trap shooting. This is YOUR club. When you join as a member, you take an interest in its operation. Help make it the best it can be. See if you can donate a few hours somewhere along the way this season. Whether it is attending a few meetings or coming out to mark a few rounds during an ATA shoot – it all adds up. The only people paid for their services in this club are the setters. Everyone else is a volunteer.
- ✿ **BE SAFE** – Safety first at all times. Keep those actions open and the muzzles down range. If you see someone not handling a gun safely, don't hesitate to let them know. You may not get a second chance. Safety is everyone's job!
- ✿ **ADDITIONAL HOURS-** The club is open on Thursdays from 10am-2pm in addition to our regular hours. This provides more opportunity to practice and post scores for those who may work irregular hours.
- ✿ **DOUBLES LEAGUE-** The doubles league is looking for shooters. A 12 week league for individuals will be starting soon. Cost is \$42.00. Sign-up on the roster posted at the clubhouse.
- ✿ **League Week #1 Starts April 26<sup>th</sup>– 1<sup>st</sup> Score is due April 30<sup>th</sup>.** Be sure to pay membership and league fees before shooting or your score will not count. Be sure to sign your team up to work or check when you are scheduled to work. Remember, someone from the previous squad is expected to mark a round for the next one.
- ✿ **First ATA Shoot April 25<sup>th</sup> & 26<sup>th</sup>** – Come out this weekend and shoot some registered targets! As usual any help with marking is appreciated.
- ✿ **ATA Shoots and Work Weeks-** Did you know your team can trade an entire work week for one day of marking at our ATA shoots? That's right, sign your team up to work one day at any of the three ATA shoots and your work commitment is complete.
- ✿ **PLEASE BE KIND TO THE SETTERS** - Do the setters a favor, check to see if the house is clear before starting a round. Let the setters know when you are finished (if they are left in the house during the round). Shut the microphones off after a round finishes. ALWAYS yield to the light bulb. If the light is on – STOP & UNLOAD IMMEDIATELY. If you see a setter not using the safety light, report it to the supervisor.
