**Be kind to the setters-** Understand whether a setter will remain in the house or not during a round. Let the setter know when you are finished if they are left in the house during the round. Shut the microphones off after the round. Always yield to the light bulb! If the light is on, STOP and UNLOAD IMMEDIATELY. If you see a setter display unsafe practices report it to the overseer.
