DO NOT tell people you can't mark because you don't come there to mark and you need to shoot another round. Everyone is there to shoot. We all need markers and we ALL need to mark. Do your part. If you have never marked before, ask someone to help you the first time. It really isn't very difficult and only takes a few minutes.
