Bylaw Changes – These previously published and presented bylaw changes were passed at the last membership meeting.

• **More Bylaw Changes** – A case was made for a few other changes regarding by laws. Although it would require another meeting to finish up the changes to the bylaws, it was decided now is the time to get it all done. Regarding Article II, Section 3 “Dues”; A motion was made to change the word following “special events” from dues to “fees” in order to avoid confusion and to change all confusing verbiage to that intended, where confusing and referring to dues verses fees while adding “membership” to meetings verses just “meetings”.

• Regarding Article V, Section 5 “Notice of Meeting”; A motion was made to change the word “Written” to “Posted” and mailed to “made available” while striking the last sentence. With the changes it will read as follows;

Section 5. Notice of Meeting

- a. ***Posted*** notice stating the place, day and hour, and purpose of all meetings of members shall be ***made available*** to all members not less than seven (7) nor more than fourteen (14) days before the date of the meeting. ~~Such notice shall be deemed delivered when deposited in the United States mail addressed to the individual at the address appearing in the record books of the corporation.~~

Changes were passed and entered into record 03/04/08.

• **THINK SAFETY** – Remember, safety first at all times. Open or OUT. Keep those actions open and the muzzles down range. If you see someone not handling a gun safely, don't hesitate for a second to let them know of their mistake. You may not get a second chance. Safety is everyone's job!

• **SCTP Youth Program** – There will be a meeting for all interested in joining the Weston Scholastic Clay Target Program held at the club house at 6:00 on March 31st, 2008. A parent or guardian is required to be present.

• **INTRODUCTION TO TRAP** – A six week course introducing new people to the sport of trap shooting will again be sponsored by the club and offered to anyone interested and holding a Hunters Safety Certificate. Contact Russ Howland for more information.

• **BE KIND TO SETTERS** - Do the setters a favor, check to see if the house is clear before starting a round. Let the setters know when you are finished (if they are left in the house during the round). Shut the microphones off after a round finishes. ALWAYS yield to the light bulb. If the light is on – STOP & UNLOAD IMMEDIATELY. If you see a setter not using the safety light, report it to the club supervisor.

• **IT IS WORTH WORKING AN ATA SHOOT** – Previously, shooting rules exempted a team that works an ATA shoot from one work week obligation. Last Year the rules were amended so a team providing 4 of 5 members for an entire ATA shoot day is then exempt from **all** workweek obligations for that league season. Sign up – first come first serve.
