✿ The first CWTA shoot of the year was held at Weston on Sunday, January 7th, 2007. It was a complete success with an enormous turn out. We registered 198 rounds! Great job and big thank you to all who helped make it such a great success. The full 2007 CWTA schedule is available on the CWTA web site or click the link on our web site.

✿ Weston is holding the CWTA 5 person team shoot on Feb. 11th, 2007. The format is a 50 target event consisting of 25 sixteen yard targets followed by 25 handicap targets shot by each team member from a yardage determined by the average of the five 16 yard scores plus two yards. The winning team will be determined by adding the two raw scores. There will be no shoot offs. Reverse score will break ties. The purse will be paid 50%-30%-20% to the top three teams. Entry will be \$15 per person with an optional \$5 individual Lewis purse and \$5 per person team Lewis purse available. Any details not addressed will be set the day of the shoot. **WE NEED HELP RUNNING THE CWTA TEAM SHOOT.** Please consider pitching in a few hours.

✿ The shooting rules were reviewed and revised at the January 2nd, 2007 membership meeting. Prices have been raised to keep up with rising costs. Member practice fees were raised from \$2.00 per round to \$2.50 per round, non-member rounds from \$2.50 to \$3.00. Summer league fees rose from \$32.00 per season to \$38.00 per season and doubles league from \$30.00 per season to \$31.00 per season. In addition, the sponsor fees are raised from \$30 to \$35 per team.

✿ **League members must pay for league make up rounds.** Substitute shooters do not pay for the rounds they shoot because they were paid for by the original team member. However, quite often the original team member is also shooting a make-up round without paying for it thinking it had been paid for when in fact the substitute shooter had shot that round. If you find yourself in this situation, please *clearly mark the score sheet "make up"* and pay for the round.

✿ It is time to start thinking about renewing the Ads for the ATA brochure. Contact Glenn Hamerly, Jack Morris or Rod Bricko if interested. Prices remain the same, \$75 for a full page, \$50 for a Half page and \$30 for a quarter page. The ATA brochure is now posted to our web site complete with ads. If you would like to place a separate ad prominently on our web site, let me know. The cost for a prominent ad on our web site is \$30 for the year. A link through ad (to your site) can be provided.

✿ The remaining dates for Hunter Safety Classes for 2007 are; February 19th thru 24th & March 12th thru 17th. All classes run Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday**, Thursday, and Saturday. Class times are 6 pm to 9 pm weekdays and 7 am to 3:30 pm on Saturday. **Wednesday is the optional Bow Hunters Course. When taken in conjunction with Hunter Safety it only adds one more night to the program. If taken separately it's another one week course. Both courses are recognized in all 50 states, Canada and Mexico. Club members have precedence in filling slots. There are only a couple openings left. ✿ The board would like to establish the nonvoting role of junior member liaison that is occupied by a junior member and selected by their peers.
